Which of the traditional Apache foods have you eaten?

What was the cause of the friction between the American settlers and the Apache?

When did the Apache Wars start and when did they end?

While being forced to live at the San Carlos Agency, how were Apache identified?

How did living at the San Carlos Agency change their lives?

While living on the San Carlos Agency, how did the Apache creatively use resources tools to mimic their traditional tools?

In 1885, which Chiricahua Apache leader led a band of Apache off the Agency?

Who helped the federal agents to track down Geronimo and his band, and what were they called?

What hard decisions did these men have to make and, ultimately, what happened to them?

In 1886, what happened to Geronimo and the nearly 500 Apache who were with him?
