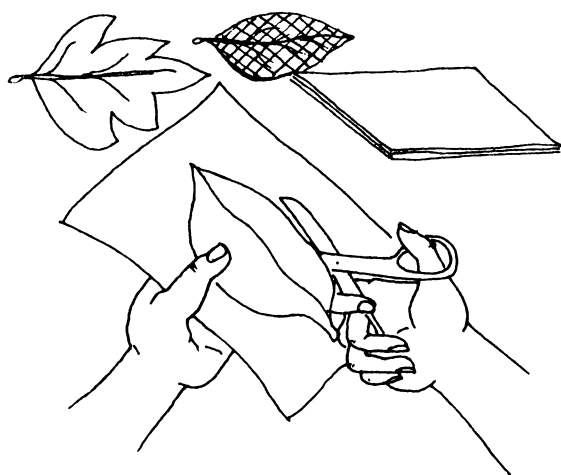

Creating a Wreath

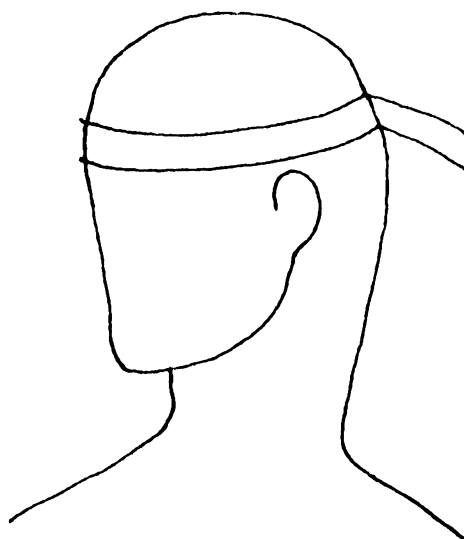
Materials: yellow or gold construction paper • 1" x 18" strips of tagboard • stapler • scissors • pencils



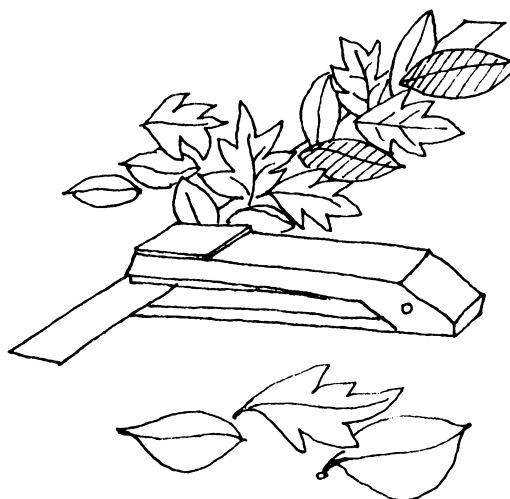
1. Gather leaves from the school grounds, looking for varied shapes. Examine the leaves closely, studying their shapes, textures, and patterns.



2. Draw the leaves on yellow or gold construction paper, and cut them out.



3. Fit strips of tagboard to the students' heads, and mark the correct length.



4. Staple the paper leaves to the strips of tagboard and then staple the strips to form the wreaths.
